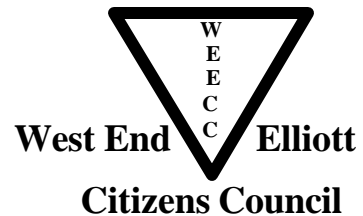
POLICE ACADEMY

\$10,000 for WEECC...

The WEECC applied for a \$5,000 grant from **State Representative Thomas C. Petrone** (Democrat - 27th Legislative District).

Specifically, this community improvement grant will be applied toward a Business and Housing revitalization

study for the main corridor in Elliott: the intersection of Lorenz & Chartiers Avenues and other areas for possible housing.

In addition, the WEECC applied for a \$5,000 grant from **Senator Wayne D. Fontana** (Democrat - Senate District 42),

that will also apply towards the housing study. It is not often the community receives this size of grant, now we have two!

The money can be used to conduct a survey that may lead to improvements to the Elliott neighborhood.

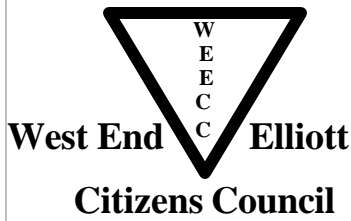
